March 31 - depart at 9:30am for shopping
at **Crown Center**. Lunch on your own.

April 5 – depart at 8:45am to hear from

Young At Heart Day. Lunch onsite for \$10.
Sign-up by March 27.


May 31 - depart at 8:00am to the
Missouri State Penitentiary. We will stop
for lunch then take a history tour of the
penitentiary. On our way back, we will stop
for ice cream at the Central Dairy ice
cream parlor. Cost is \$25 plus your lunch
