Joyful Giveaway. Over a decade ago, our church began a ministry at Christmas time that we call the *Joyful Giveaway*. We wanted to do something for our community and even our region that would demonstrate the love of Jesus in tangible ways at a time of the year when people seem especially receptive to the gospel. The original idea was pretty vague. We were really just thinking about what we could do to help others, then share with them the reason we feel compelled to help: the love of Jesus! When we first shared the concept/vision about it, we had an interest meeting one Sunday after church. I remember saying, "If we can have 50 people at this meeting, this is going to work!" We had over 150 at that meeting, and frankly, we've never looked back.

The Joyful Giveaway allows us to: share the gospel with each participant, offer to pray with them, give them groceries, feed them while they're here, choose toys for their children (and children choose gifts for their parents), have various health screenings, have family pictures taken, printed, and framed to take home, give clothing (mainly caps, gloves, socks and PJs), and give haircuts.

As you can imagine, it takes a lot of effort and time, energy, and financial resources to share an event like this with our area, but it has proven to be well worth the effort! Periodically, I will see someone that will say to me, "Hey, you're the guy with the church that does that cool event before Christmas!" It's good to be known as a church family for giving! People know we're not looking for anything from them. We simply share the joy of the season because we have the joy of Jesus to share.
