
Come, Thou Long Expected Jesus!

It is our prayer that these readings will not only fill our hearts with joy as we anticipate the celebration of Jesus' birth, but that they will also cause us to long for His return. In the words of the beloved Christmas hymn published by Charles Wesley in 1745:
